- Asynchronous events dispatching.

[JAFS 0.9.9](#) : Completing the collaborative source java enterprise suite.

We're glad to announce the new JAFS release which brings major changes to the project :

- New customizable events engine for EAI needs.
- LZMA based new bootstraper, old JAR binaries size reduced of fifty percent.
